

TEXAS LIMOUSIN ASSOCIATION'S LONE STAR SHOOT OUT RULES

- TLA membership must be current for each breeder (\$100 fee) to nominate heifers.
- Heifers must be purchased directly from a TLA breeder with active membership.
- Heifers can be transferred from the original TLA breeder to a Texas junior exhibitor. Heifers can then only be transferred between siblings.
- Heifers will only qualify for one year of eligibility and must be the first available Shoot Out Show.
- A sponsored heifer sold to an immediate family member is ineligible for the Shoot Out Show.
- Heifers that are 25%-49% are eligible to show in the Shoot Out, but will fall in the ORB division for the Fort Worth Jr. Heifer Show.

NOMINATED BY ONE OF 3 CHOICES:

Nominating an entire herd:

- Whole Herd entry fee \$350 due by June 15.
- Each heifer entry fee \$200 Due by December .
- TLA will promote heifers on TLA Facebook and website at no charge.
- Whole herd breeders will receive special recognition at shows and TLA News.

Consign a heifer to a TLA Sanctioned Sale:

- The \$225 entry fee will be deducted from sale proceeds.

Place an ad on the TLA Facebook, website or newspaper:

- The ad price is \$50 per head for social media. To nominate selected heifers from your herd in the TLA News, standard rates will apply.

Late entries after December 1. :

- If nominated as listed above will pay \$250 late fee
- Non nominated heifers are ineligible for the show
- All entry fees and nominations are non-refundable
- All fees collected are put towards a goal of a \$10,000 purse
- Each participant will receive a check regardless of place standings

Exhibitors:

- Each exhibitor is required to be a TJLA member \$20 dues must be current
- Each exhibitor must submit an entry application by December 1. Entry application, copy of registration paper, and \$25 fee must be returned to Brittini Allerkamp TLA Executive Secretary. All entries after December 1 will be \$50.

Texas Limousin Association reserves the right to retrieve DNA for parentage verification on all Shoot Out heifers.
